Auditorium

Located on the Museum's ground floor, the Auditorium is the largest private room in the building, offering the perfect space for seated dinners or standing buffets.

With in-built audio visual facilities, lectern and stage, the Auditorium is also ideal for conferences, lectures or film screenings.
